

# Are you still suffering from chronic rhinosinusitis (CRS) despite having sinus surgery?

If so, consider participating in the BEACON clinical research study, which is evaluating an investigational product as a potential new therapy for CRS.

The BEACON study will explore whether the study product can safely improve CRS symptoms. The study product is a small, flexible mesh that fits inside your nasal passages, where it slowly releases a medication called mometasone furoate (MF). MF is an approved corticosteroid commonly used to reduce swelling.

You may be able to join the BEACON study if you have CRS and have had previous sinus surgery. Other requirements apply.

## Study participants receive at no cost:

- Possible access to the study product for about 6 months
- Regular monitoring of your CRS symptoms
- Study lab tests and support from a healthcare team
- Education about CRS
- The opportunity to help advance CRS research
- Reimbursement for time and effort related to the study
