The **CONTRAST-NP** study is now enrolling adults who have Chronic Rhinosinusitis with Nasal Polyps (CRSwNP). This study is assessing an investigational medicine to see if it can help reduce symptoms.



**You may qualify for the CONTRAST-NP research study if you:**

- **Are 18 years of age or older,**
- **Meet criteria for a diagnosis of Chronic Rhinosinusitis and have nasal polyps in both sides of your nose (bilateral),**
- **Have had treatment with systemic corticosteroids (for example, oral or injectable) within the last two years (unless unable to use them), and/or have had prior surgery for nasal polyps.**

**If you volunteer and qualify for the CONTRAST-NP research study, you may receive no-cost study medication and no-cost study-related medical care.**

The CONTRAST-NP study is enrolling adults diagnosed with Chronic Rhinosinusitis (inflamed nasal sinuses) with nasal polyps. Chronic Rhinosinusitis (or sinusitis) is a condition that can cause long-term symptoms including sinus pain/pressure and nose stuffiness — even a decrease in one's sense of smell. Nasal polyps are benign (non-cancerous) growths in the nasal cavities\* that can affect a person's quality of life and make sleeping difficult. Some may also have asthma, a disorder that affects the airways, which can make it even harder to breathe.

Current treatments only provide short-term relief, may result in disease recurrence, and/or may still require surgery. For these reasons, researchers are working hard to develop a new medication to see if it can help reduce symptoms. But we need volunteers of diverse backgrounds to ensure this investigational medicine will work for all types of people.

\* Nostrils are the openings to the nasal cavities.
